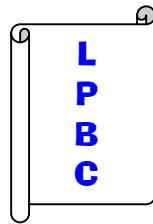

**Meetings** – The next meeting is scheduled for March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2006 at 7:00 PM in the Longmont Library Conference Room. We will be discussing the up-coming election cycle, several declared candidates, some un-declared candidates, local elections, and SAFER petitions, among other things. In fact, LPBC has joined with NORML for Boulder to help distribute SAFER petitions for the up coming Statewide Ballot Initiative to Decriminalize Marijuana.



**Upcoming** – Besides the Statewide MJ Initiative, LPBC is getting behind the Eminent Domain Initiative, formed to prevent local governments from condemning citizens land, and then handing it over to developers for “community improvement”. We have petitions available. We are also set to make inroads into Broomfield County, which has had no Libertarian Party representation ever since they broke away from Boulder County. The Boulder County Clerks Office specifically invited the Chair of the County Libertarian Party to participate in the upcoming election equipment selections. Local county government recognizes that there is a third party presence in Boulder County!
